- Discuss with patient about:
- (a) stop smoking

(b) Weight management with diet & exercises(c) Refer the patient to GP for medications

HOW NURSE HELPS PATIENT IN QUIT SMOKING


- Discuss the harmful effect of smoking
- Brief discussion about the services available
- Refer the patient to stop smoking services
- Contacting patients around 12-14 weeks
- Review patient at one year

Re-assessment at 1 year

Patients were re-assessed by Nurse between 01/09/2014-30/09/2015

Re-assessed for Smoking=70 Re-assessed for BMI= 49 Re-assessed for medication=49
