It is important that you understand how we use your personal information



The person checking you for Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm is called a screener



Please look at this card and let the screener know if you have any questions or worries



The NHS in England offer this A.A.A screening service to make sure you are healthy and safe



We need your permission to scan your tummy using ultrasound and to let you know the results



If you have an A.A.A we will need to tell a specialist doctor called a vascular surgeon

Information that we keep could be



- What you tell us about your health



- Pictures that we take of your aorta



- The results of your scan



We need your permission to keep your information.



We keep information about today's visit on our computer system, this information is kept very safe, we need this information so we can help you get a good service.



We may use your information to help with research for the NHS; we will not show your name.
